In honor of Veterans Day, the acclaimed artist [Greg Lauren](#) is opening a week long “retail installation” named ‘Barracks’. The installation is made up of 30 one-of-a-kind pieces, which include tailored jackets, shirts, and unique accessories. Every item is created from repurposed military fabrics that came from vintage Army Duffle bags, Tents and Parkas. Even the wool found in the collection started out as vintage U.S Navy jumpers. All of the garments and accessories were hand crafted in Lauren’s Los Angeles based Art Studio. A percentage of all sales made during the week are being donated to the Operation Mend Veteran’s Charity.

Each article of clothing is signed by Greg Lauren himself. The artist takes the time to hand write each label with his name, spare button, and a care label, truly making each piece an individual work of art.
